THE CREWING SERVICE

This is a short guide regarding the job application process with Lock & Load and we ask all new applicants to **read it in full** before proceeding with the application. Due to circumstances beyond our control and to be able to cater for our clients, applicants need to fulfil certain criteria explained below.

We are a crewing service providing labour for various venues in the greater Melbourne area. Due to the nature of our work we need all our crew to have a Construction Induction Card, also known as White Card. This is a mandatory requirement working for Lock & Load. If you don't have a White Card, follow this [WEBLINK](#) and get one straight away. **No White Card means no work.**

The Lock & Load License & ID Data Sheet is for us to stay compliant with specific requirements of venues & clients.

Very often we are asked for certain information before we can send crew, and this is the best way to keep track of it. All collected information is for work purposes only and kept confidential.

Please take pictures of all relevant licenses & ID's and upload them to the data sheet the way the sample data sheet to the right shows. The passport section is only relevant for applicants that don't hold an Australian ID.

Due to the complexity of today's application process and the involved paperwork we will only consider applications with fully completed Lock & Load Application Form and Lock & Load TFN Form. This is for the purpose of speeding up the application & interview process, to get you set up in our system in the most efficient way and to get you out to work as quickly as possible.
